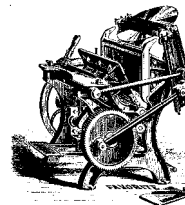

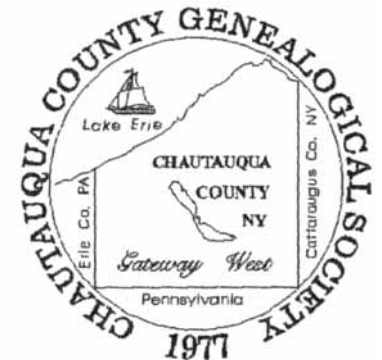

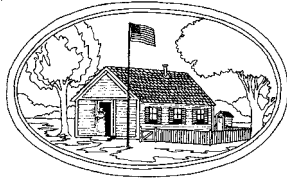

Information from these surviving reports was extracted by several members of CCGS. Included are the names of head of household and the number of children of school age in that household. For some years, the names and ages of children are given. An index of children with surnames other than head of household is included in each volume.
